

## Race Rules



1. **Disqualification** – At any time, disqualification without pay may be enforced by track management.
2. **Judgment Calls** – All calls on the racetrack are at the discretion of officials and are considered judgment calls.
3. **Safety Equipment** – Safety equipment is mandatory to race. You must have a neck restraint, gloves, a fire suit, fire-retardant shoes, seat belts and helmet with valid dates. Failure to have safety gear will be disqualification without pay or points.
4. **Double-File Starts** – The race starts in the Starting Zone marked by two flags in Turn Four. The pole sitter must start the race between those flags—starting early will result in a penalty. If the outside pole sitter jumps the start before the pole car, that car will be docked. If the pole sitter does not start by the last flag, the race is considered underway.
5. **Single-File Restarts** – For single-file restarts, the pole sitter starts the race in the Starting Zone. Cars 1, 2, 3, 4, etc., must maintain single-file formation through the cone on the front stretch, or they will be docked 2 positions.
6. **Racecivers** – Racecivers are mandatory. If you do not have one, you will be disqualified. Use channel 454.000.
7. **Transponders** – Transponders are mandatory. We use Yellow Westhold Transponders, which must be mounted on the right rear axle tube. You are responsible for ensuring your transponder is charged and properly installed.
8. **Getting out of your car on the track, unless instructed by track officials, will result in disqualification with no pay.**
9. **Using your car as a weapon under caution will result in a one-week suspension. A second offense will result in a one-year suspension. Both offenses will receive no pay.**
10. **If you are deemed to be racing through the infield under any condition, you will be scored last in position and points.**
11. **Speeding through the pit area will result in being scored last in position and points.**
12. **No riding on cars. The first offense will result in a warning. The second offense will result in no pay and no points.**
13. **Going to another driver's pit area and causing a physical altercation will result in a two-week suspension with no pay and no points.**
14. **If you are caught in the pit area without an armband, you will be escorted to the pit gate and required to pay double for that night or leave. A second offense will result in being barred for one calendar year.**
15. **Any harassment of a track official at any point during the night will result in a two-week suspension with no pay and no points.**
16. **If you are not in the lineup chute for your event, we will not wait for you. Help us run an efficient show.**
17. **You may only run one class per night—no double dipping.**
